



1. What is Back to Church Sunday?

On September 12th 2010 thousands of people across Australia will be inviting someone special back to church with them. People lose touch with church for all sorts of reasons but millions would come back with an invitation.

Back to Church Sunday began in one Anglican diocese in the United Kingdom in 2005 and since then has spread to all 44 UK Anglican Dioceses and also across denominations. On Back to Church Sunday in the UK in 2008, people in 3,000 Anglican Churches invited and welcomed back 37,000 friends.

On Sunday 12th September it is BACK TO CHURCH SUNDAY in Australia. You are all invited to participate.....



Back to Church Sunday was trialled in Australia 2008 at St Paul's Anglican Church in Chatswood in the Anglican Diocese of Sydney.
